

## NLA Web Database Licence Fee Tariff 2016

Rates to apply from **April 1<sup>st</sup> 2016** unless and until amended pursuant to the terms of the Agreement and/or Licences. All prices exclude VAT, which is payable in addition where applicable.

Capitalised terms have the meanings given to them in the Web Database Licence unless otherwise stated.

### 1. Web Database Licence - Newspapers

The Fees for the Web Database Licence (see [here](#) for list of sites covered) are as follows:

a. The Licence Fee shall be based on the number of Clients to whom the Licensee is providing the Licensed Services as follows:

b. The Licence Fee will be reduced in the event of certain reductions in the number of websites covered by the Publisher Content. These reductions are described below. For the purpose of these reductions, 60% of the Licence Fee is nominally attributable to the "National Websites" (identified below) and the remaining 40% is nominally attributable to the "Regional Websites" (also identified below).

### National Websites

The National Websites included in Publisher Content as at the date of this agreement are made up of the following 6 "National Sets":

The Licence Fee shall be reduced by 10% for each National Set that is removed from Publisher Content during the term of this agreement.

**Regional Websites**

The Regional Websites included in Publisher Content as at the date of this agreement are shown in the list of websites comprising Publisher Content which can be found at [NLA website](#)  
 If the number of Regional Websites included in Publisher Content falls below a total of 500 then the Licence Fee shall be reduced in accordance with the following table:

**Number of Regional Websites**

Included in Publisher Content	Licence Fee Reduction (%)

c. Where the Licence Fee has been reduced under paragraph b. above, the Licensee shall be entitled to a refund equivalent to the amount of that reduction on a pro-rata monthly basis for the remainder of the Year.

d. If the number of publisher websites comprising the Publisher Content as at the date of this agreement reduces by 50% then the Licensee shall have the right to terminate this agreement on 1 (one) month's written notice to NLA and the provisions of clauses 6.11 and 9.3 shall apply.

**2. Web Database Licence – Magazines**

- a. The Licence Fee shall be based on the number of Clients to whom the Licensee is providing the Licensed Services as follows:

b. The Licence Fee will be reduced in the event of certain reductions in the number of magazine websites covered by the Publisher Content as follows:

c. Where the Licence Fee has been reduced under paragraph b. above, the Licensee shall be entitled to a refund equivalent to the amount of that reduction on a *pro-rata* monthly basis for the remainder of the Year.

d. If the number of magazine websites comprising the Publisher Content as at the date of this agreement reduces by 50% then the Licensee shall have the right to terminate this agreement on 1 (one) month’s written notice to NLA and the provisions of clauses 6.11 and 9.3 shall apply.

**Service Fees**

For Links and Text Extracts that are delivered under the Web Database Licence, the fee per Link will be:

- 6.3 pence for the first Link sent to the first Permitted User at a Client or a prospective Client (Existing Licensees)
- 9.5 pence for the first Link sent to the first Permitted User at a Client or a prospective Client (New Licensees)

For Links and Text Extracts from Premium magazines, that are delivered under the Web Database Licence, the fee per Link will be:

- 12.6 pence for the first Link sent to the first Permitted User at a Client or a prospective Client (Existing Licensees)
- 19 pence for the first Link sent to the first Permitted User at a Client or a prospective Client (New Licensees)

For offline digital Web Articles that are sourced using the Web Database Licence, the fee per Web Article will be:

- 11.2 pence for each Web Article made available to a Client or a Prospective Client
- 22.4 pence for each Premium Web Article made available to a Client or a Prospective Client

For Paper Copies of Web Articles that are sourced using the Web Database Licence, the fee per Paper Copy will be:

- 4.5 pence for all Paper Copies delivered to a Client or prospective Client
- 9 pence for all Premium Paper Copies delivered to a Client or prospective Client

**3. Audit Fee**

A fee is payable to cover audit costs as follows:

#### **4. Default Fee**

In respect of the each Licence, you will pay us fees set out in the Fee Tariff in force during the period of that Licence, together with the audit fee and where applicable, the scanning fee and the default charge set out in the Fee Tariff in force during the period of that Licence.
